## 1000 Words A Rebel's Brief Triumph

He was the king of Port-au-Prince for all of two days, a boyish figure in black fatigues who led a bloody rebellion and then proclaimed himself Haiti's new military supremo. But Gen. Philippe's reign was aborted after a 15-minute meeting with a U.S. Marine colonel, who told him it was time for his men to lay down their arms. Philippe vowed to withdraw from the city. But was that the last anyone would hear from him? Not likely.
