AND THE SANTA CRUZ, THE SAN ISIDRO,  
AND MORONG EXPEDITIONS DURING THE  
PHILIPPINE INSURRECTION, PARTICIPAT-  
ING IN 24 ENGAGEMENTS, WAS MUSTERED  
OUT AT SAN FRANCISCO SEPT 25, 1899.  
ARRIVED IN GRAFTON OCT. 2, 1899
