Partisan candidate ballot order:

Candidate ballot order is determined following Minnesota Statutes [204D.13](#) and [204D.08](#). For the office of president and vice president of the United States, major parties are listed first on the ballot in reverse order of their average votes in the last election, and minor parties are listed after major parties in an order determined by lot. For all other partisan offices, candidate ballot order is determined at random before the election. The order of candidates on the actual ballot in your precinct rotates using a formula for rotations ([Minnesota Rule 8220.0825](#)).

Nonpartisan candidate ballot order:

Candidate ballot order is determined at random before the election (Minnesota Statutes [204D.14](#); [204D.08](#); [206.61](#)). The order of nonpartisan candidates on the actual ballot in your precinct rotates using a formula for rotations ([Minnesota Rule 8220.0825](#)).
