



Mayor Humphrey Of Minneapolis

As the youngest Mayor elected by the largest majority in Minneapolis history, Hubert Humphrey had little administrative power against a corrupt and uncooperative city council. Mayor Humphrey instead used the office as a bully pulpit, bringing the fight directly to the people by forming citizen committees to confront the discrimination of minorities, restructure the police department, and solve dozens of other municipal problems.
